Below are the results of the **Have Your Say** survey on three separate topics, which was sent out with the last CroydonVision magazine.

In question 1, you were asked to comment on the difference the Disability Discrimination Act had made on your lives and people with disabilities in general. 59% stated a positive difference for yourselves and people with disabilities, 2% found little or no difference while 14% said you do not know enough about the Disability Discrimination Act to be able to comment.

Each respondent was sent a copy of the new CroydonVision magazine and you were asked to state the parts of the magazine that you enjoyed the most, found most interesting or most informative. Most of you enjoyed the whole magazine, with Get to Know Us the most popular feature, and the other responses ranged across a variety of news snippets and articles throughout the magazine.

Question 2b asked you to comment on what you would like to see in CroydonVision in the future. We received a range of really great ideas, which we will be working on for future issues, including: entertainment and leisure activities for people with disabilities, problems disabled people have with access and some solutions, more about hearing problems – “the unseen problem”, more news on sports to name but a few.

Question 2c asked if you would recommend CroydonVision to other people? The pie chart dark shaded area represents the answer “yes”.

For future Have Your Say funding we needed your views on the project as a whole. We asked you to place in priority order reasons why the project is important.

You voted on this order of importance;

1. to enable disabled people’s views to be heard and taken into account.
2. to achieve improvements in access to existing services.
3. to be consulted in preferred formats.
